SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

Due to the constant ICT evolution, ICT are more and more integrated in everyday life aspects. Education, as the main way to individual development, also participates in this trend. However, educators find them hard to integrate them in their classroom and use them as a vehicle for better learning. The aim of this seminar is to offer to teachers ways to integrate a selection of free ICT tools in their classroom, in such a way that students will benefit the most, learn how to communicate, collaborate and be creative

On day 6 we focus on Blogs and how they can be used in class. Participants will cooperate in groups and build a blog from scratch. We'll show how to design and plan a blog, so it can be "live" and supportive on teaching process.

Participants they will learn how to make the blog student friendly, add plugins and how to introducing it to the school community. In the end each group will evaluate the blog of other groups.

Day 7 Digital storytelling

Digital Storytelling has become a powerful instructional tool for both students and educators. This day we will present an overview of Digital Storytelling and describe where it came from and how it can be used to support instruction In addition, information is presented about the tools that can be used to support the educational use of Digital Storytelling. We will also discuss of challenges and other important considerations that students and educators should be aware of before implementing the use of Digital Storytelling in the classroom, and how to effectively use of Digital Storytelling as a teaching and learning tool.

Participants, working in groups, will apply all the above, on various free online storytelling tools.

HOW TO GET HERE Syros

is located centrally in the Aegean Sea. You can travel to Syros by plane or ferry. There are daily flights to Syros from Athens, while ferry connection with main port of Athens are also very good.

Ferries to Syros

The island of Syros is easily accessible by boat from the port of Piraeus (the main port of Athens). There are ferries to Syros from Piraeus, every day. As Syros is located centrally in the Aegean Sea, it serves has ferry connections with many other islands of the Aegean Sea, such as Mykonos, Andros, Tinos, Ikaria, Lesvos and more. The port of Syros is at Ermoupolis. There are two types of ferries servicing the island:

Regular ferry boat service

Duration: 3 hours and 45 minutes

High speed ferries (during the summer only)

Duration: 2 hours and 20 minutes
